Shield Road School graded highly by Ofsted

In a recent Ofsted inspection Shield Road Primary School in Filton has been judged as 'good' in all areas and 'outstanding' in some.

The inspectors said teaching and learning were good; that "pupils develop positive attitudes and enjoy learning from an early age. Pupils say lessons are fun but also take learning seriously."

Nick Moss, the Headteacher, said he was delighted. "We are very proud that our school has received such a good report and been graded so highly."

The team that visited the school in Shields Avenue said Mr Moss had been the driving force behind many of the rapid improvements. "His management and day-to-day support for the staff and pupils is exemplary and shows a

tireless personal commitment," the report said. "Parents agree and say the school is being pulled together well."

Pupils with learning difficulties are supported very effectively and their progress is outstanding. Higher attainers are challenged well. Care and support for pupils and personal development and well-being of children is also good.

Shield Road has a lot to offer its pupils and parents including a schools for health awareness, an impressive range of clubs and other extra curricular opportunities; a popular breakfast club, an after school club, a community room and Bluebells Pre-School is on site.
